RCI Budget 2015-2016

The RCI budget was presented with a total estimated budget of \$273,304 which includes student paid tuition. School participation rates will stay the same with each small schools (0-9 students) contributing \$6,070.50, medium schools (10-19 students) contributing \$12,815.50 and large schools (20+ students) contributing \$18,105. Participating schools are Corry, Fort LeBoeuf, Wattsburg, Northwestern, Girard, Fairview, Millcreek, and Union City.
