DESCRIPTION: At the fall Occupational Advisory Committee meeting, the course of study for Computer Programming was discussed. OAC members feel that COBOL programming is becoming obsolete. They recommend more instruction in HMTL Programming to give our students stronger skills in web page development. Four new Computer Programming HTML courses are proposed; they are replacing a series of legacy programming courses in COBOL. Courses being eliminated are:

CMP340 COBOL Programming I (30 hours)
CMP341 COBOL Programming II (45 hours)
CMP342 COBOL Programming III (30 hours)
CMP343 COBOL Programming IV (45 hours)

Course syllabi and an updated course sequence chart will be implemented upon approval.
