

Admissions Coordinator Board Report

May 2015

The Dinner with Teacher event for new students took place on April 23. 158 families attended. This event is designed to allow students and parents to interact with the teacher in order to be comfortable coming to ECTS next fall. It also affords incoming students the opportunity to meet other new students. The event was very successful. We served roughly 500 people. The efforts of student volunteers from Culinary Arts, Culinary Instructors, and the ECTS Maintenance staff were greatly appreciated. They all played an intercool part the planning and hosting of this event.

The fourth quarter Guidance Counselor meeting will take place on May 29th. ECTS is very appreciative of all the Counselors have done to support current students and assist in the admissions process, to get the right student in the right place for the right reason. We have 349 new students coming in the 2015/16 school year. Until the new school year begins changes in enrollment will be very limited. All students admitted will begin the school year and any newly interested students will visit at the beginning of the year. The Counselors have been a great help in developing these new guidelines.
