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Career Objectives/Career Pathways

The Career Planning Coordinator or CPC has been working with students on their Career Objectives as part of their educational plan. In addition, the CPC will soon begin working with students and instructors to complete their Career Pathways. The pathways will assist students in analyzing the relationship between career choices and career preparation opportunities.

“Ready To” Series

The CPC presented an SAT/ACT registration workshop on Sept 11, 2014 from the *“Ready for College”* series targeting seniors who wanted to re-take the exam or for those seniors who needed to take the exam for the first time. Additional workshops to assist students with the SAT/ACT registration process will be offered throughout the school year. Workshops to assist interested seniors with choosing a college, applying to college, and paying for college are being planned and will be offered during the first and second quarters. The CPC also regularly provides students with scholarship information and available resources to help with the cost of post-secondary education.

Advanced Training Day

The CPC has also been busy planning for Advanced Training Day, scheduled for Oct 16, 2014. Over 50 colleges, trade organizations, employers and military representatives have been invited to participate in this event; to date 25 have committed to attending. ECTS’s Advanced Training Day showcases some of the post-secondary opportunities that exist for our students following their high school graduation.

WIN Training

The CPC attended a WIN “Train the Trainer” workshop on Aug 14 at Edinboro University. During this daylong event, the CPC was able to become familiar with the software and some of the administrative functions available. The CPC also plans to attend further WIN training on Oct 13, 2014.
