NOCTI- School Performance Profile

Dr. Jackson presented the superintendents with an in-depth look at the NOCTI test and the impact on individual school's School Performance Profile (SPP) scores. Aldo explained the test format, elements of the test, and how it is administered. Superintendents viewed the ECTS NOCTI Improvement Plan and discussion encompassed the elements of the test.

SY2016-17 Budget

The lack of the budget for school districts will delay any discussion of next year's budget forecast for the districts and subsequently the ECTS budget.

Transition Center Reimbursable Program

Dr. Jackson discussed the merits of seeking certification for some of the programming for students in the Transition Center. Two other schools in the state have something similar. Further investigation will be needed to assess the feasibility of applying for certification.

Emerge 2040 Update- Broadband

Dr. Jackson informed the superintendents that the comments they made regarding the lack of accessible broadband services and the impact to student learning were relayed back to the Emerge 2040 team. Dr. Jackson will give monthly feedback to the superintendents regarding the development plans for broadband expansion.
