During the review faculty will have the opportunity to take notes on potential students as a retention tool. Students answer 3 questions on the application and their answers reveal very interesting information about the student and their aspirations.

Following that review students will be assigned a status based on seats available per program and per district as well as appropriateness. I will spend the beginning of February meeting with each sending school Guidance Counselor to review each applicant and their status.
