Desktop Systems

Working with Windows 10, and building the base image for consideration towards deployment next school year.

Applications and Database

Working with Grade Summary and Report Card reports and processes to fine-tune and improve upon the process and reports we began creating at the tail end of last school year.

Working with the Admissions coordinator to finalize the Admissions web-based application review process.

Working with Student Support to develop a resource scheduling process to aide in delivering instructional support to students. We've used traditional calendaring, reviewed an Outlook/Email Calendar approach, and are considering other alternatives.

Network and Server Systems

Continuing to roll out the 10GB Switch infrastructure, and working with multiple vendors to quantify an affordable option to replace our fiber from 1990's grade FDDI/OM1 to current technology OM4 Fiber that will support 10GB transmission and beyond.

Working with our Facilities Manager to identify a low-cost partial plan to upgrade our security camera system. The equipment is extremely old, and lacking in any support. It has endured several component failures in the last year alone and the evolution of technology continues to obsolete it further. The Skills Center unit, which used to serve the main building until 2006, is not accessible on many systems because of software incompatibility. Both the Skills Center and Main Building units are unable to be reviewed from any smartphone or tablet based device increasing the difficulty for the Facilities Manager to provide remote surveillance during weather or other environmental events; or ease the administrations access to recorded events.
