Last Day for Students and Teachers:

Thursday, June 2nd was the last day for the Erie County Technical School students. The day was filled with lab activities and parties that celebrated another successful year.

Friday, June 3rd was the final day for the instructional staff. Again the ECTS family shared in a closing luncheon that included NOCTI program recognitions and service milestones.
