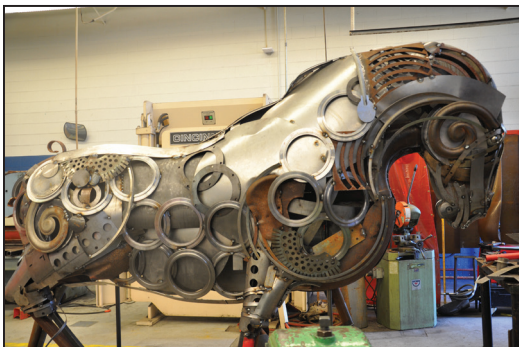
Community Art Project
