

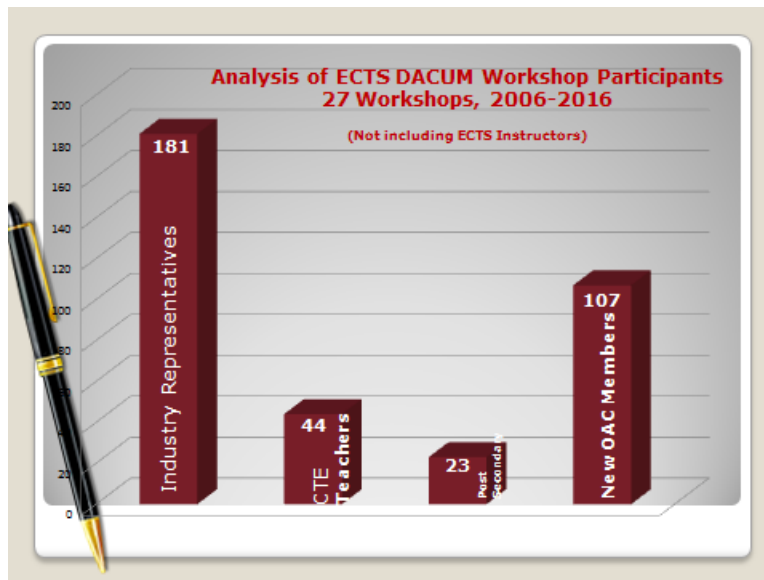
Supervisors of Instructional Support Services Report
