Calendar Committee

ECTS Renovation Plan- QZAB Funding

Dr. Jackson presented the superintendents with an overview of the elements of the Qualified Zone Academy Bond program. There was a discussion of the multiple options for renovation. There will be continued research and discussions.

Three Sessions-

Dr. Jackson explained the concept of the sessions and the benefit it would award to the technical school programs. Superintendents will begin discussion with their respective guidance counselors. ECTS will host a joint meeting with Guidance Counselors and Principals to explore the options, scheduling and transportation issues associated with the concept.

Career Street

Jennifer Pontzer provided an update and handouts regarding NIE and an outing planned for teachers to introduce the many opportunities available for student career exploration by utilizing Career Street. Jennifer presented a draft of the first issue of the NIE Career page and solicited comments from superintendents. A Trolley Tour is planned for November for History teachers and Guidance Counselors. Career Street will provide funding for the bus transportation.
