

High School Activity Report

August 2016

Principal Meeting:

On Tuesday, August 9th, the principals of the Erie County Technical School consortium met for the first of four scheduled meetings for the 2016-17 school year. Joe Tarasovitch shared information to ensure that each district and ECTS were prepared to support students' needs that were returning to ECTS; and the new enrollees. The Principals also discussed IEP students at the Career & Technical center, PDE recommendations for High School graduation requirements, alternative assessments/clinical supervision/differentiated supervision.

Preliminary Enrollment:

As of August 18, 2016, the projected enrollment for the Erie County Technical School was at 809 Students. There are 12 programs that are projecting a 90% or better enrollment capacity as of this date: ADS, AUR, AUT, CMP, CNT, COS, CUA, ECE, EET, GRA, HEA, MTF.
