Last Day for Students and Teachers:

Thursday, June 8th was the last day for the Erie County Technical School students. The day was filled with lab activities and parties that celebrated another successful year. Friday, June 9th was the final day for the instructional staff. This year the ECTS family shared in a closing brunch that included NOCTI program recognitions and service milestones.

The instructional staff recognized for service milestones was: Mark Cyphert for 25 years of service, Jeff Zellefrow, Corey Long, Matt Walter, and Travis Woodburn for 1 year of service.

ECTS 4th Quarter Recognition:

Perfect Attendance: 132 students had Perfect Attendance in the 4th Quarter which represented 18% of the ECTS student body.

Honor Roll Students: 179 students achieved the Honor Roll status in the 4th Quarter which represented 24% of the ECTS population.

Distinguished Students: 42 students earned the recognition of DISTINGUISHED STUDENTS in the 4th Quarter; which is 6% of the ECTS population.

Exemplary Students: 6 students have earned the outstanding status of EXEMPLARY STUDENT for the 2016-2017 school year. These students will be presented to the JOC in the September 2017 Board Meeting for a well-deserved public recognition and a special presentation.
