

Sept 2016 Board Report Career Planning Coordinator

Career Objectives

- The annual PDE Educational and Occupational Career Objectives forms were updated and introduced at the PACTA conference in September. The new forms require the addition of Standard Occupational Classification codes to be included. The SOC and CIP code crosswalks were provided by PDE last week.

WIN

- WIN training was attended on Sept 15. The software has a new career exploration piece with some additional features. The strategic compass now includes additional inventories for students to complete and learn more about themselves.
- Usernames and Passwords have been received from WIN and the faculty has received updated rosters.
- CPC has begun to introduce WIN to students in the classrooms. To date 75% of our students (578 of 765) are active in the system and 41% (310 students) have earned a career readiness certificate.

NOCTI

- The bulk of NOCTI pretesting took place on Oct 4 & 5. Make-up test days were also provided for absent students and for students needing additional time on the test.
- NOCTI Study guides were ordered and have arrived for dissemination to the instructors.
- NOCTI pretest score reports have been received and provided to instructors.
- NOCTI pilot testing will take place in January for eligible labs. 3 Instructors have expressed interest in taking advantage of this opportunity.
- NOCTI post-testing will take place in April

Advanced Training Day

- Advanced Training Day is scheduled for Oct 19, 2016.
- Over 50 colleges, trade organizations, employers and military representatives were invited to participate in this event; 43 have committed to attend. ECTS's Advanced Training Day showcases some of the post-secondary opportunities that exist for our students following their high school graduation.
- A letter inviting parents to attend the Advanced Training Day was mailed out to all of our students' parents.
