Career Street

Jennifer disseminated the individual school information for the *8th Grade Career Readiness Survey* for 2016 to attending Superintendents. She outlined projects for the 2016-17 school year to include the continuation of the *Newspaper in Education* project which highlights career information for school students, Tech Fest and Manufacturing Day, and a collaboration with Mercyhurst University to produce a coloring book with a career focus that can be used with 3rd grade students.

Math Credit at ECTS

Dr. Jackson reported that the Tech School will continue to move forward with creating an opportunity for a math credit for ECTS students.

Countywide PreK-20 Education Leadership Group

Dr. Jackson presented a proposal for a Countywide Education and Training Leadership Consortium which evolved from the Erie County Emerge 2040 initiative.
