Joe Tarasovitch and I visited the school districts to greet the new students for the 2018-19 school year. We gave each an ECTS gym bag, shared some information about the logistics of attending ECTS. Students were very excited. We took photos of each group. Look for those photos to appear in each high school.

Dinner with Teacher is April 26. We are expecting about 500 people including staff and support people from the community. This is a wonderful opportunity for students to meet other students, become more familiar with ECTS, and begin to form a relationship with the Instructor.

As schools are scheduling for next year, we are seeing many students interested in visiting for a half day and applying. Admissions will close on May 1. After that date, any applications submitted will be held until the beginning of the school year. At that time the applicants may visit and decide if ECTS is a good fit for them. The exceptions will be students on the waiting list for over-subscribed programs. If a space becomes available due to student decline, I will contact the next students on the wait list to fill the spot.

I have been invited to speak to 8 graders and to present ECTS to 6th graders at several schools. These younger age groups are very interested in Career and Technical Education. It is fun and exciting to work with the middle school age group. I hope to grow these presentations into each district.
