Ready for College

- Scholarship information continues to be provided to students on an ongoing basis.

Ready to Work

- Lessons on cover letters, resumes, thank you letters and reference continue to be offered in the classroom by the CPC. Students can also schedule individual time to work creating and revising these documents.
- Apprenticeship and Training Coordinators have been invited to come and act as guest speakers in our labs.
- In response to student request, the CPC is offering ASVAB testing at ECTS on April 30 between 12:00 – 2:30pm for interested students.

WIN

- The CPC continues to be utilized for WIN implementation and support in the classroom.
- The CPC continues to work in the classrooms with students. To date 91% of our students (677 of 742) are active in the Career Readiness system and 50% (336 students) of these students have earned a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum Career Readiness Certificate. 179 students are active in the Soft Skills Curriculum and 69 (39%) have earned certificates.

NOCTI

- NOCTI testing took place between Monday, April 9 – Friday, April 13th.
- Approximately 240 students participated in testing

Activities & Awards

- Each month, the Career Planning Coordinator accepts nominations from the faculty for the Millcreek Kiwanis Citizenship Award. The prerequisite for this award is “an individual who has demonstrated moral character, courage, leadership, health and physical fitness, service, recognition received for their efforts, scholastic preparation and total citizenship.” Students receive certificates of achievement and are eligible to apply for a Kiwanis scholarship.
