

High School Activity Report

April 2018

Third Quarter Recognition: The 3rd Quarter ended on March 27th; with that conclusion ECTS was able to recognize the accomplishment of three outstanding groups of students:

- **PERFECT ATTENDANCE:** 137 students had Perfect Attendance which equates to 19% of the student body.
- **HONOR ROLL:** 127 students achieved the Honor Roll status, or 18% of the student body.
- **DISTINGUISHED STUDENT:** 42 students obtained the honor of Distinguished Student which is 6% of the student body.

NOCTI Testing: The Erie County Technical School seniors completed the NOCTI testing process during the week of April 9th 2018. The testing process consist of two parts; an “ON-LINE” test and a “PRACTICAL” test. During the days of April 10th and 11th, the labs were engaged with the “ON-LINE” portion of the test, and on April 13th the entire senior class was engaged in the “PRACTICAL” portion. Mr. Tarasovitch and Mr. Lewis would like to recognize the outstanding job that Remle Moyak did in organizing the testing process, and thank the ECTS staff for supporting Mrs. Moyak’s efforts.

Perkins Grant Mandatory Meeting: Mr. Tarasovitch traveled to Parkway West in Oaksdale, Pennsylvania on Thursday, April 12th to participate in the annual mandatory Perkins Grant meeting. The school’s representation at the meeting is mandatory so that ECTS is in compliance with PDE and the expectations with the grants submission.

Principal’s Meeting: The Erie County Principals gathered on Tuesday, April 10th for the fourth and final time of the 2017-18 school year. Mr. Lewis shared student attendance and grade concerns for each district, along with the end of year activity schedules for the ECTS senior graduation.

In addition to the regular meeting, School Resource Officers from Girard and Northwestern conducted a demonstration/presentation of the NAVI-GATE Prepared Emergency Website.
