Annual Refresh of New Computers

Computer Programming and Graphics new computer deployments are complete. The computer that were removed have been refurbished for re-deployment to our staff offices, and is underway.

New Production Design Printers

A new 5 color (white ink on dark paper) printer in Art and Design and an envelope printer in Graphics have been installed.

New Infinite Campus Period Structure

Infinite Campus Report Updates

Nearly all of our reports, including admissions reports have had to be extensively rewritten. The new period structures, the testing we are doing with RCTC in Infinite Campus, as well as some updates Infinite Campus has made to their systems have warranted these necessary updates to our reports.

Supporting District and Personal BYOD

Network Segmentation plan is on hold for various reasons, but will be rolled out over the next few months incrementally. This work is being done to better support district and personal device access to presentation (Projectors and TV's) displays, and printers.

Microsoft Office365 Cloud

Our Microsoft Educational Agreement was finalized August 1st, and we have begun leveraging all that we can with Microsoft Office365 and Cloud services. We are waiting until next summer to migrate existing data to these cloud services, when we have the opportunity to significantly widen our internet connection by re-joining the RWAN consortium that was re-established this past year. We unfortunately are unable to terminate our existing contract this year.
