

High School Activity Report

February 2018

Second Quarter Recognition: With the end of the second quarter occurring on January 18th, ECTS recognized outstanding students in these categories:

- **HONOR ROLL:** 142 students achieved the Honor Roll status; 19% of the student body
- **PERFECT ATTENDANCE:** 101 students had Perfect Attendance in the 2nd quarter which represented 14% of the ECTS population
- **DISTINGUISHED STUDENT:** 35 ECTS students achieved the Distinguished Student recognition which accounts for 5% of the student population. This list was received in January.

Perkins Revision Meeting: Dr. Jackson, Terri Birchard, Jeff Smith, and Joe Tarasovitch reviewed the Perkin's Grant funding and the possibilities of revisions to the grant. Mr. Tarasovitch issued a final request for "field trips" from the instructors, and a final utilization of approved purchases. Terri Birchard will review the finds available after the forementioned request have been completed to determine if a revision is necessary for the March 31, 2018 deadline.

Military Presentation: On Wednesday, January 24th a "military" panel presentation was held at the Erie County Technical School. This was the 5th year that this type of presentation was conducted at ECTS. Mrs. Moyak moderated the sessions that had military representatives from every branch of service.

Tornado Drill: A campus-wide tornado drill was conducted in the AM and PM sessions on Wednesday, January 31st. Both drills were completed with the appropriate decorum and cooperation from everyone involved.

A review of the ECCPA strategic plan took place along with discussion regarding the next steps of the committee. Planning for the launch of the Science and Health Industry Advisory Group was also reviewed.

Collins Writing: Dr. Heather Mashetta visited ECTS on February 5th to continue work with instructors who are using Collins Writing. Collins Writing is designed to improve student thinking and writing skills simultaneously.

Blood Drive: Mr. Eggleston led the organization of a Blood Drive held Monday, February 12th. The Erie Community Blood Bank spent nearly the entire day at ECTS. Ninety students and staff volunteered. A total of 64 donated, while 26 were unable to participate because they did not meet medical criteria outlined by the Blood Bank.
