Capital Outlay Funding Formula Alternatives

The superintendents discussed an alternative to the current Market Value formula outlined in the Articles of Agreement. Specifically, the proposed alteration would reduce Millcreek's project share from 36% to 31%, with the other ten (10) county school districts picking up an additional 5% share of the project each.

The consensus of the group was to recommend leaving the Market Value formula unchanged for capital outlay funding.

Food Service Contract

Dr. Jackson reported that, based on Chris Sennett's research, the current food service contract with Nutrition Inc. can be terminated with a 10 day notice. Northwestern and Fort LeBoeuf school districts are the only two schools that have students served lunch at ECTS. They are working on plans to provide lunch for their students so that the contract with Nutrition Inc. can be terminated this school year.

Math Class

After consulting with the participating districts' guidance counselors, it has been concluded that the ECTS Math Class must continue for at least one more year for the juniors currently enrolled due to graduation requirements.

Moving Forward:

The superintendents will discuss the need for the future of this program with their high school principal and guidance counselors to determine if there is a need or interest for the course to continue beyond next year and make a final recommendation.
