

Progress Report
Study for Proposed Additions and Alterations
Erie County Technical School
March 19, 2018



The HHSDR team of architects and engineers have started the initial steps of the study. This began on March 1, 2018 with interviews of the Administrative Team and tours of the building. The following are highlights of our progress.

- Observed each interest program in operation to evaluate the spaces' effectiveness, including theory rooms and changing rooms.
- Reviewed locations for building additions to support program expansions.
- Reviewed building security issues.
- Reviewed life safety systems (emergency lighting and power, fire alarm, etc.).
- Reviewed ADA accessibility..
- Reviewed technology.
- Reviewed plumbing system condition.
- Reviewed HVAC equipment, temperature control condition and service access.
- Reviewed lighting and power distribution condition and adequacy.
- Reviewed window, door, hardware and finishes conditions.
- Reviewed educational equipment (display boards, cabinets, etc.).

We are proceeding to document these conditions into a report to show the current state of the building. We are also beginning to graphically explore options to reorganize and expand certain programs to improve the delivery of instruction.

Following these tasks, we will be developing two cost projections, one to address current deficiencies only and one to address redesigned and expanded programs as well as addressing the current deficiencies.
