Purpose

A guidance counseling program is an integral part of the instructional program of the career and technical ~~vocational~~ school. Such a program can:

1. Assist students in achieving their optimum potential.
2. Enable students to significantly benefit from program offerings.
3. Identify intellectual, emotional, social and physical needs.
4. Aid students in recognizing options and making choices in career and technical ~~vocational~~ and academic educational planning.[\[1\]](#)
5. Assist students in identifying career options consistent with their abilities and goals.

Authority
