Math Class Tablets

Google device management is not yet managing these new devices 100%, and a case remains open. Google Chrome browser has been unlocked to support lessons that are leveraging online content and interactive sites.

Cosmetology Millenium POS

We enabled the Cosmetology Millenium POS system to connect to an SMS/Text service at Mrs. Noonan's request. Additionally, it is published to the internet so that students can access the scheduling component on other devices.

Navigate Prepared

We are working to improve wireless coverage in a few outdoor areas to support the Navigate Prepared application.

Office 365

We continue to setup our Office365 tenant. We have tested Skype, Sharepoint, and Outlook services at this point, and are evaluating our migration plans. There are disadvantages to moving all of our eligible data and services to Office 365, but there are also trade-off to remaining in a split/hybrid environment where some services are on-Premise, and some are in cloud. We are working with the onboarding team at Microsoft to evaluate the best strategies.

Admissions Database

Completed the setup of the 18-19 Admissions Database. This entailed compiling of the freshman lists from the districts, importing the data into SQL, and updating the SQL Reports Server reports.

Internet Application Priority

Worked with CDX Automotive to prioritize their online education services in our internet policies. Differentiating content with traditional content filtering strategies is increasingly unreliable. We use prioritization to improve content quality with school related content.
