Ready To Series...

- Faculty members were asked to conduct the first “**ready to learn**” lesson on note taking/ test taking/ study skills with their classes by the end of Q1.
- The next lesson from the ready to learn series is being developed.
- The second year of the piloted “Ready to Work” series begins this month.
- As part of the “ready for college” series, scholarship information continues to be provided to our faculty for dissemination to students.
- Workshops on college applications & scholarship searches are planned for late Oct/early Nov.

Career Objectives

WIN

- NOCTI pre-testing ended on Oct 12th.
- Scores are being processed by NOCTI and will be disseminated to faculty once they have been released.
