Curriculum Development

NOCTI Testing – Thank you to all of our staff, students, and evaluators for a great NOCTI testing week. We successfully tested 209 seniors. Results are available and our staff has received the test reports. A special thank you to Mary Foulkrod for taking on the co-coordinator role and assisting with the details that led to a successful testing week. A list of the business and industry representatives that evaluated our seniors is attached to this report. We appreciate each evaluator giving of their time and expertise to test our students.

Articulation – Thank you to Sherry States, Health Assistant Instructor, for coordinating an articulation with IMBC. IMBC is offering up to 12 credits for health assistant concentrators. Edinboro University of Pennsylvania has requested an amendment to our agreement for Early Childhood Education articulation agreement. This amendment adjusts for the change in course numbers and names. We have reached out to Pittsburgh Technical College and Butler County Community College for articulation agreements with various programs.
