Page 8 – SIGN IN/OUT PROCEDURES

2. Students who arrive late in the morning (after 8:15 AM) or afternoon (after 12:15 PM) must report to the high school office to sign in.

Page 11 – PERSONAL COMMUNICATION DEVICES PROHIBITED

According to the PA School Code (24PS13-1317.1):

1. The possession by students of telephone paging devices, commonly referred to as "beepers", shall be prohibited on school grounds, at school sponsored activities and on buses or other vehicles provided by the school district.
2. The prohibition contained in subsection (A) shall not apply in the following cases, provided that the school authorities approve of the presence of the beeper in each case:
 - a. A student who has a need for a beeper due to the medical condition of an immediate family member.

Changed to:

The Joint Operating Committee prohibits use of electronic devices by students during the school day in school buildings – **except at designated times approved by the ECTS administration**; on school property; on school buses and vehicles; during the time students are under the supervision of the school; and in locker rooms, bathrooms, health suites and other changing areas at any time.
