Although there is a decline in overall registrations, this “decline” represents the changes made to the PA State Emissions testing. RCTC no longer proctors recertification testing. Initial emissions testing has slowed down considerably during the phase-in of the new testing. Despite lower numbers in Term II, overall revenue for Terms I & II of 2018-19 have increased over the same terms last year.
