Administrative Procedure 126—Alternatives for Interventions

Purpose of Interventions: Procedure 126 is intended to establish a sound process for the annual review of program enrollments. In the event that program review warrants some level of intervention, the Joint Operating Committee (JOC) remains the final decision-making authority regarding the ECTS programs. When considering programs in the spirit of Procedure 126, the JOC may stipulate any of the following courses of action:

Action	Process Description	Timeline
A. Continue the program in its current state		
B. Continue the program with modifications	1. Put program(s) into a curricular redevelopment plan. 2. Put program(s) into a recruitment development plan. 3. Put program into a marketing development plan. ***Any program subject to this action would be considered "at risk."	Annually
C. Alter the program attendance/enrollment structure	1. Convert the program(s) from full time to part-time attendance/enrollment in either the morning or afternoon session.	Annually
D. Curtail the program	1. Discontinue admissions to the program(s). 2. Prepare a "teach-out plan" for students currently enrolled in the program(s).	February J.O.C. meeting
