Enrollment

Below is a snap shot of current enrollment as of the 2/21/2019. Changes will occur until 5/1/19. After that date no students will be dropped or admitted unless a very special circumstance occurs. I have been meeting with each sending school Guidance Counselor to discuss the admission status of every applicant. These meetings are invaluable and provide a plethora of information for our teachers to understand where students are academically, socially, and emotionally when they enter ECTS. At this time we have approximately 31% of new students taking honors classes and 31% with IEPs or 504 plans.
