JOC Declaration of Health or Public Crisis (COVID-19) Implications; Hybrid-A/B
Schedule

DESCRIPTION:

The Erie County Technical School's Educational Leadership Team recommends that the Joint Operating Committee makes a "declaration" for an emergency plan due to the continued concerns of health and public concerns; COVID-19 implications. By making this declaration, the Joint Operating Committee will utilize the authority granted to the committee from Section 520.1 of the Pennsylvania School Code to adjust/modify the instructional days/hours during a school year due to a crisis or emergencies.

The Erie County Technical School will begin the 2021-2022 school year fully engaged with "in-person" instruction, but reserve the option to utilize a "blended" schedule of in-person and virtual on-line instruction utilizing the A/B Day schedule approved.

The schedule will be initiated, if such a health and public concern (COVID-19) warranted a change, and remain in effect pending the health and public concern status changes.

RECOMMENDATION:

Motion to make a "declaration" to adopt an emergency plan due to a health and public concern (COVID-19) during the 2021-22 school year with a "blended" schedule of in-person and virtual on-line instruction utilizing the A/B Day schedule approved.
