Curriculum Development

Student Certifications – Instructors are entering the student certifications earned during the current school year into CTE-360. Current certifications offered are compared to the PDE Industry-Recognized Credentials for CTE programs.

Curriculum – Tasks and standards are aligned to unit plans in CTE-360. Summer curriculum work will include adding additional information to unit plans. A motion is included on the agenda to approve summer curriculum work. Instructors will submit any curriculum changes to the scope and sequence for their programs by the end of the school year.

Program Re-approval – Sandy is completing the information updates to PDE's CATS system for program re-approval. Information needed for this project includes labor market information, OAC member lists, course descriptions, task list crosswalks, accountability targets, equipment and technology, support service descriptions, advisory committee information, articulation (including secondary and post-secondary scope and sequence information), student and instructor certifications, and accreditation information. The deadline for submission is May 31, 2021.

NOCTI/NIMS - Senior NOCTI testing for the written component concluded on May, 10, 2021. Results have been downloaded and 144 students scored "Advanced", 33 students scored "Competent" and 7 students scored "Basic". Students from Precision Machining have completed components of the NIMS test. We are awaiting test results.

Award Ceremony – Senior ceremony was held at ECTS on May 26, 2021. Seniors could bring two guests and the ceremony was live-streamed for other friends and family members. The link for the recorded ceremony is available on the ECTS website.

Roster Verification- We will provide sending school counselors and case managers comprehensive lists of next year's students and will ask them to verify that we have properly identified all of the students with disabilities who will be attending ECTS in the fall.
