April 2022

Current Enrollment: As of April 20th, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is operating at 72.6% capacity with 662 students. This is an increase of 31 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 35 students. This is an increase of 12 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.
