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## *High School Activity Report*

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### **August 2021**

**Principal Meetings:** On Tuesday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, Joe Tarasovitch hosted the quarterly meeting for the Erie County Principals. Julie Aiken was introduced as the new Principal. Joe shared information to ensure that each district and ECTS is prepared to support students' needs that are returning to ECTS, and the new enrollees. The principals were also notified of the proposed plan to start out the 21-22 school year at ECTS wearing masks for at least the first month; with weekly meetings to update the masking plan via the guidelines from the CDC.

**Preliminary Enrollment:** As of August 12, 2021, the projected enrollment for the Erie County Technical School was at 752 students. There are eight programs that are projecting a 90% or better enrollment capacity as of this date: CMP, CNT, COS, ECE, EET, FMT, HEA, MTF.

**Survey Results:** The data from the current Student Satisfaction Survey, Parent Satisfaction Survey, and Class 2019 Postgraduate Survey were reviewed by the administrative team and will be share with the faculty at the upcoming in-service day. Building-wide highlights include "My child enjoys going to the ECTS" and "The technical school is a safe place for my child", among others.

**Secretarial Support:** The secretarial staff – Pam Lasher, Pam Pence, and Renee Heberle did a tremendous job working together to ensure that the high school and adult education programs were ready for the 21-22 school year. Our annual student and faculty letters were mailed. And an additional mailing was sent to all students, sharing FAQ about COVID-19, and the mask covering waiver request form. The administration appreciates their teamwork to support the school and the instructors.
