January 2022

Current Enrollment: As of January 19th, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is operating at 77.3% capacity with 705 students. This is an increase of 28 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 34 students. This is an increase of 10 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.
