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Curriculum Development

Instructors continue to work on unit plans in CTE-360. Eleven of our programs have updated task lists for the 2021-2022 school year and alignments are complete in CTE-360. The Professional Learning Committee met on January 19 to discuss changes taking place to Infinite Campus grading next year. Instructors will schedule times for the curriculum audits.

NOCTI Testing

Mary Foulkrod and Sandy have started planning for April's NOCTI testing. Written tests will be administered the week of May 2. Instructors are contacting evaluators for the performance test scheduled for April 26-28. We have approximately 200 seniors testing this year.

Special Education

Second quarter grade reports for students with disabilities were sent to the special education teachers, case managers and guidance counselors. Our instructional aides are working with students on project completion, organization, and portfolio completion.
