Director's Report
June 2022**

Erie County Technical School Auction:

The Erie County Technical School conducted an auction on May 26, 2022. The auction was conducted under the guidance of Wheeler Auctioneering LLC, and organized by Rob Estok, the Clerk of the Work for the building and renovation project. The auction was a success with 259 items from the 261 offerings being sold. The profit from the auction was \$30,752.24.

Senior Awards Ceremony Event:

The Erie County Technical conducted the “Senior Awards Ceremony” on June 1, 2022, at Fort LeBoeuf high school. The event had three separate presentations to support the safe practices of social distancing due to COVID-19 status in Erie County being at the “High” transmission level. The evening was successful with 203 seniors from ECTS and additional 16 from the Transition Center being honored.

Employee of the Month:

Mr. Michael Miller the ECTS Technology Supervisor was chosen as the May EOM. Michael was recommended by 2 Professional Unit members, 2 Classified Unit members, the Clerk of the Work, and supported by the administration for his “welcoming” approach of wearing several HATS during May. Mike supported the school in his usual capacity, but also was acting as a substitute instructor for the Computer Networking program on practical learning days and supporting the clean-up and storage of the CMN equipment and supplies for the building and renovation project.

Perkins Grant Submission:

The Perkins Grant funding was announced for the 2022-23 school year; ECTS will be allotted \$349,253. This year’s funding has a minimal decrease of \$758 or .2% decrease from the 2021-22 school year. The formal Perkins Application was completed and forwarded to PDE on Monday, June 13, 2022. This submission will provide ECTS with a spending date of July 1, 2022.

Renovation Status

- a. Construction on North Addition – Frame construction completed; plumbing inspected, and cement floor completed. Interior wall framing, wiring and plumbing being addressed.
- b. Frame Construction on South Addition – CUA, 2 Additional Lab Spaces Completed; ECE steel delivery scheduled for May 16, 2022.
- c. Frame Construction on Administration Addition; Steel arrived earlier than expected; steel framing being addressed.
- d. New High School Office framed, drywall and finishing.
- e. New Student Services Office framed, drywall and finishing.
- f. Auto Body Repair, Automotive Technology, Precision Machining Technology, Health Assistant and Cosmetology areas emptied and starting demolition work.

Roundabout Status:

Second “Detour” plan scheduled for Monday, June 13, 2022 – closing Oliver Road from the Five Points intersection going east on Oliver Road. The detours will be to utilize Hamot Road, Flower Road.

ECTS Operations:

1. ECTS Comprehensive Plan will be submitted to PDE prior to the August 31, 2022, deadline with JOC approval.
2. End-of-the-Year conferences and evaluations will be conducted with the administrative staff in July of 2022. The conference will provide a dialog to commend and discuss plans for the 2022-23 school year.
