
High School Activity Report

March 2022

Current Enrollment: As of March 16th, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is operating at 73.9% capacity with 674 students. There is no change from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 35 students. This is an increase of 12 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

Faculty Meeting: The monthly faculty meeting was held on March 3rd. Topics that were discussed included an update on the ARP-ESSERS grant, the upcoming spring OAC meeting and NOCTI exams.

Support Workshops: Mrs. Aiken held optional mid-day workshops to support the teaching staff. Topics included the Student Performance Measure documentation and the development of their Domain 4 binder, both of which are components to the teacher evaluations. Several teachers signed up to work with Mr. Andrew Pinney during a work-session to develop classroom materials using M.A.X Teaching Strategies.
