Curriculum Development

Articulation – We are reaching out to our post-secondary partners to request forming or renewing articulation agreements. We have a renewed agreement for our Early Childhood Education major with NPRC and have a revised articulation agreement with IMBC for our Health Assistant and Sports Therapy and Exercise Science programs.

Student Certifications – Instructors are entering the student certifications earned during the current school year into CTE-360. Current certifications offered are compared to the PDE Industry-Recognized Credentials for CTE programs.

Curriculum – Some instructors have finished or are nearly finished with the unit plans in CTE-360. Summer curriculum work will focus on working with new instructors in updating sequence charts and preparing curriculum documents. A motion is included on the agenda to approve summer curriculum work. Instructors will submit any curriculum changes to the scope and sequence for their programs by the end of the school year.

Program Approval – Sandy is collecting and entering the information for PDE's approval of the Sports Therapy and Exercise Science program in the new CATS system. The deadline for submission is June 30, 2022.

NOCTI/NIMS - Senior NOCTI/NIMS testing is complete for our 196 seniors. Results have been downloaded and 115 students scored "Advanced" (59%), 53 students scored "Competent" (27%), and 28 students scored "Basic" (14%).

Award Ceremony – Senior ceremony will take place Wednesday June 1st at Fort LeBoeuf High School. Seniors can bring four guests and the event will be livestreamed via the ECTS Facebook page.

Roster Verification- We will provide sending school counselors and case managers comprehensive lists of next year's students and will ask them to verify that we have properly identified all of the students with disabilities who will be attending ECTS in the fall. Sandy and Lesa continue to communicate with sending schools and attend meetings for accepted students with IEP/504 plans.

Instructional Aides –End-of-year evaluations for the Instructional Aides will be completed soon. Their support of our students and staff is instrumental to the success of the Erie County Technical School and we are grateful for the services they provide.
