
High School Activity Report

October 2021

Current Enrollment: As of October 19th, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is 717 students. This is an decrease of 7 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 33 students. This is an increase of 10 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

Faculty Meeting: The monthly afterschool faculty meeting was held on October 7th. Topics that were discussed included the 2022-2023 budget requests, an outline for the 9th grade tours in November, an overview of the Domain 4 portfolios for teacher evaluations, and the upcoming Walk-for-Wishes event. Additionally, Mr. Miller demonstrated the messaging tool available in Infinite Campus for class-wide communication with parents.

In-Service: On October 11th, the faculty completed a day of In-Service training on “Special Education Essentials” and completed their fall Occupational Advisory Committee (OAC) meetings.

Safety: ECTS has conducted fire safety drills for the month of October, utilizing the NaviGate Prepared system. A lockdown drill will be conducted prior to the end of the month.

Scholarship Recipient: During this year’s Manufacturing Day event, our Electrical Engineering student, Trevor Johnston (Fairview) was awarded the Patrick R. Locco Scholarship.

National Technical Honor Society Induction: On October 14th, the 17 new members of the National Technical Honor Society were inducted into the ECTS chapter. Thank you to advisors Allison Marendt & Mariea Sargent on organizing a wonderful event for our inductees and families.

Walk-for-Wishes: Mr. Tarasovitch kicked off our annual Make a Wish Foundation fundraiser with a virtual presentation. The ECTS goal is to raise at least \$4,400; to grant at least one wish.
