
High School Activity Report

September 2021

Current Enrollment: As of August 14, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is 734 students. This is an increase of 25 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 34 students. This is an increase of 11 students from the 2020-2021 school year at this time.

In-Service: On August 27 & 30, the faculty completed two days of In-Service training in preparation for the new school year. Areas of training included COVID-19 protocols, Microsoft TEAMS, Infinite Campus, Act 13 Evaluations, CTE360, SafeSchools Training, and more. A special thank you to Michael Miller & Lesa Scalise for all of their preparations and presentations.

Faculty Meeting: The first afterschool faculty meeting was held on September 2. Praise was given by the faculty to the technology and maintenance departments for all their hard work and support in preparation for the new school year. Topics that were discussed included Professional Learning Communities, NOCTI pre-testing, the fall Occupational Advisory Committee (OAC) meeting, requesting substitutes, and a National Technical Honor Society (NTHS) update on the membership application process.

Student Orientation: The instructors presented the student handbook and ECTS expectations to the students using a student orientation PowerPoint, followed by a brief introductory video from Mrs. Aiken. This format was in lieu of a large group presentation by Mrs. Aiken due to COVID-19 restrictions.

Safety: ECTS has conducted fire safety drills for the month of September, utilizing the NaviGate Prepared system.

Approved Program Evaluation (APE) Audit: The Erie County Technical School will be audited by the PA Department of Education in late September. The audit process is a review of each of the school's programs and satisfies Chapter 339 of the state regulations. The preparation for this audit is quite extensive; a team approach has been used for gathering and organizing data.
