Curriculum Development

Curriculum – The Professional Learning Communities (PLC) groups continue to develop unit plans utilizing CTE-360. The PLC Leadership team will assist instructors with development and alignment with standards. PLC meetings are scheduled throughout the school year.

New Program – We have met to look at CIP Code information and tasks list for the 51.2604 Rehabilitation Aide program. We will market the new program as Sports Therapy and Exercise Science. We met to develop marketing taglines and met with the Erie County Science and Health Pathways Alliance to recruit business and post-secondary partners.

339 Audit – We have reviewed the documentation and have prepared for the 339 virtual audit scheduled for September 27-30, 2021.

NOCTI Testing– Seniors will take the NOCTI pre-test the beginning the week of September 27. We will have 203 seniors take the pre-test this year.
