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## *High School Activity Report*

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### **September 2022**

**Current Enrollment:** As of September 14, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is 804 students. This is an increase of 70 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time. Eight programs are operating at 90% capacity or higher.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 38 students. This is an increase of 4 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

**In-Service:** On August 26 & 29, the faculty and instructional aides completed two days of In-Service training in preparation for the new school year. Areas of training included Infinite Campus, purchase protocols, roles of the instructional aides, changes and reminders, SafeSchools Training, and more. A special thank you to Michael Miller, Sandy Carr, & Lesa Scalise for all their preparations and presentations!

**Faculty Meeting:** The first after-school faculty meeting was held on September 1. Topics that were discussed included the fall Occupational Advisory Committee (OAC) meeting, requesting substitutes, and the new year checklist for faculty.

**Student Orientation:** A video from Mrs. Aiken was presented the students, covering key points from the student handbook and ECTS expectations. Mr. Tarasovitch's video presentation on the students with PRIDE was also shared with the students. This format was in lieu of a large group presentation due to renovation restrictions. Deputy Yeane met with all students with her presentation on her role and reminders for success.
