
High School Activity Report

October 2022

Current Enrollment: As of October 19th, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is 796 students. This is an increase of 79 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 39 students. This is an increase of 6 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

Faculty Meetings: The monthly afterschool faculty meeting was held on October 6th. Topics that were discussed included the OAC meetings, the ECTS Comprehensive Plan, and the upcoming Walk-for-Wishes event.
