Program Re-Approval

Sandy continues to collect and enter information into the new CATS reporting system for Program Re-Approval. All program information must be entered into the new system by December 30, 2022.

Curriculum and Textbooks

As we prepare the budget, Sandy is meeting with instructors to discuss curriculum resources and textbook options.

Special Education

Sandy and Lesa met with instructors to review the IEP's and 504 plans of their students.

We are excited to have Angela Plummer as an addition to our Instructional Aide staff. There are now 9 Instructional Aides supporting students in the traditional ECTS programs and 3 Instructional Aides supporting the Transition Center. Our instructional aides are assisting with meeting the educational needs of our students.

Lesla and Sandy are meeting with the special education faculty at the sending districts to discuss the application process and special considerations for students with special needs interested in or already attending ECTS. Strengthening communication and understanding between schools increases support and success for students with IEP and 504 plans.

NOCTI

The majority of our seniors completed the NOCTI pre-test in the spring. Pre-test and 2022 senior written and performance test data was sent to Todd Luke from Max Teaching. Todd has generated a series of reports that will assist our teachers and students to prepare for the 2023 written and performance tests.
