
High School Activity Report

December 2022

Current Enrollment: As of December 14th, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is 789 students. This is an increase of 84 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 39 students. This is an increase of 5 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

Faculty Meeting: The monthly after-school faculty meetings were held on November 3rd and December 1st. Topics that were discussed included Recruitment tours, Open House, SchoolMint, Literacy expectations, and the ECTS Season of Giving.

Safety: ECTS has conducted fire safety drills for the months of November & December. Deputy Yeane is conducting presentations for each program on Teen Dating Violence.
