CATS System

As of January 17, 2023, all of the Erie County Technical School programs are re-approved in the new CATS reporting system.

CTE-360

Instructors have entered industry-recognized certifications earned by students into the CTE-360 program. We will be sending this information to the sending schools so that these credentials can be included on student transcripts. We have some instructors that are working with students to utilize the on-line portfolio features of the system.

NOCTI Testing

Mary Foulkrod and Sandy are planning for April's NOCTI testing. Junior students will take the pre-test on Thursday, March 30. Senior will take written tests on Thursday, April 20. Instructors are contacting evaluators for the performance tests scheduled for April 25-27. We have approximately 216 seniors testing this year.

Instructors have received information regarding the NOCTI teacher resource center and are developing plans to prepare students for testing.

Special Education

Second quarter grade reports for students with disabilities were sent to the special education teachers, case managers and guidance counselors. Sandy and Lesa are communicating with students and parents to develop student success plans as needed.
