
High School Activity Report

February 2023

Current Enrollment: As of February 5, the current enrollment for the Erie County Technical School is operating at 84.3% capacity with 769 students. This is an increase of 91 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time. The overall current retention rate is 96%; 3 programs at or above 100%, 12 programs 90% or higher, and 3 between 80%-89%.

The current enrollment for the Transition Center is 39 students. This is an increase of 4 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

Faculty Meeting: The monthly after-school faculty meeting was held on February 2nd. Topics that were discussed included building renovations, procedure 126, lab cleaning expectations, the Domain 4 Binder, School Mint applicant ratings, and the upcoming spring OAC meeting and NOCTI exams. Additionally, mid-day meetings included NOCTI performance review and the upcoming in-service day.

Semester Conference: Mr. Tarasovitch and Mrs. Aiken met individually with all instructors for mid-year conferences. This time was used to review current status regarding their evaluation components, address any concerns that they have, and complete the semi-annual evaluation for applicable faculty members.

Safety: ECTS has conducted severe weather and fire safety/evacuation drills for the month of January and February.

National Technical Honor Society: The ECTS chapter organized a very successful Valentine's Day "gram" event. Students and staff were able to order candy or flower grams that were organized and delivered on Valentine's Day by the NTHS members. Students also hosted a food drive, collecting boxed cereal and jars of peanut butter. 221 jars/boxes were donated to our local food bank!
