Curriculum Development

NOCTI Testing – On March 30, the majority of our juniors took the NOCTI pre-test. In total, 212 juniors were tested. On April 20, 208 seniors completed the NOCTI written test. The performance tests is scheduled for April 24-28. We will have approximately 50 volunteers from business and industry evaluating our students. We appreciate the assistance from the sending schools in keeping our sophomores and juniors during the performance testing. Many thanks to our instructors and instructional aides with assisting in the testing process.

Articulation – Butler County Community College is offering 6 credits and 20 hours of volunteer/work experience for our Sports Therapy and Exercise Science program completers.
