Current Enrollment: Concluding the 2022-2023 school year, the Erie County Technical School was operating at 83.6% capacity with 762 students. This is an increase of 97 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

The concluding enrollment for the Transition Center was 37 students. This was an increase of 3 students from the 2021-2022 school year at this time.

Senior Awards Ceremony: The Senior Awards Ceremony was held on Wednesday, May 31, 2023 at Fort LeBoeuf High School. The graduating class gathered in three groups to celebrate.
